LOCAL RULE 75.1

F. OMISSION/REDACTION OF PERSONAL IDENTIFIERS:

1. The following rule shall apply, except with respect to documents that the Court, pursuant to law, maintains under seal.
2. When submitting a case document to a court or filing a case document with a clerk of court, a party to a judicial action or proceeding shall omit personal identifiers, as that term is defined in Sup. R. 44, from the document. The last four digits of social security numbers and the last three digits of financial account numbers may be included.
3. Redacted or omitted personal identifiers shall be provided to the Court or clerk only as required by law, or upon request by the Court, or to a party by motion. Redacted or omitted personal identifiers shall be filed on a separate form under seal. HC Form 270.00 shall be used for this purpose.
4. The responsibility for omitting personal identifiers from a case document submitted to a court or filed with a clerk of court pursuant to division (D)(1) of this rule shall rest solely with the party. The court or clerk is not required to review the case document to confirm that the party has omitted personal identifiers.
