**PROVISIONAL ORDER TO TRANSFER GUARDIANSHIP
[R.C. 2112.31]**

This matter came before the Court for hearing on the Petition to Transfer Guardianship. The Court finds that evidence was presented that the ward is now physically present or is reasonably expected to move permanently to the other State. The Court finds that reasonable and sufficient plans for care and services for the ward in the other State have been made. The Court finds that adequate arrangements will be made for the management of the ward's estate in the other State. The Court is satisfied that the Court of the other State is likely to accept jurisdiction. The Court finds that no objections have been filed. The Court finds that the transfer is in the best interest of the ward.

Therefore it is ORDERED that the Petition to Transfer Guardianship be and hereby is provisionally granted and the guardian shall file to be appointed guardian in the other State.
