This memorandum Witnesseth
That whereas John P. Atwater as Executor
of the last Will of Ethan Stone has received
various sums of money belonging to said
estate, amounting to Seventy nine thousand
Two hundred and Eighty three ⁸²/₁₀₀ Dollars.
and has purchased therewith on his own
account, rail road stocks and bonds of
which a list is hereto attached, which sums
of money with interest thereon from the
respective times when received and used
to the tenth day of May A.D. 1856 amounts
to Thirty two thousand and Seventy five ⁶⁰/₁₀₀
Dollars: the said John P. Atwater hereby de-
posits with Thomas M. Jackson the said
stocks and bonds to be held by him as
security, that the said John P. Atwater,
executor as aforesaid, shall account for
and pay over to the said residuary lega-
tees of the said Ethan Stone deceased de-
scribed in said Will so much of the said
amount of money and accruing interest
thereon as shall upon distribution be due
severally to said legatees and also has ex-
ecuted and delivered to the said Jackson
a mortgage upon real estate in the City
of Cincinnati upon the same conditions
It is also understood that the said
John P. Atwater shall be at liberty to sell

and dispose of any of the said stocks
and bonds for his own use at any time
or replacing the same with other securities
of equal value to the satisfaction of the
said Jackson and shall also have the
right on producing and delivering to the said
Jackson a certificate or certificates of deposits
of any sum or sums of money issued by The
Ohio Life Insurance and Trust Company
or Groesbeck & Co in the joint names of said
Jackson and Atwater or issued by The Ohio
Life Insurance and Trust Company to
J.P. Atwater executor and transferred with
the endorsed assent of that company to said
Jackson and Atwater to have the amount
thereof entered as a credit upon said mort-
gage to date from the date of said certificates
and to withdraw from said Jackson ~~that~~
amount of the said stocks and bonds the
market value of which at the time shall
be equal to such certificate or certificates,
The said Jackson shall further deliver to
said Atwater from time to time as they
