Of Fund For Support Of Religion in
Storrs Township.

This cause coming on to be heard on the report of A.L.

Tischbein, Trustee, of the election held October 1, 1923, under the Will of the said Ethan Stone, deceased, to determine to what denomination the amount given by the said decedent's will for the support of religion in Storrs Township shall be paid, was submitted to the Court and on consideration thereof the Court finds that on October 1, 1923, the Storrs Congregational Church, representing the Congregational denomination, received 1307 votes, The St. Martini's German Protestant Evangelical Church, representing the Evangelical Protestant Church of North America as a denomination, received 1141 votes and that the First German Protestant Church of Price Hill, representing the German Evangelical Synod of North America as a denomination, received 238 votes and that no other votes were cast at said election and that neither of the said churches belong to the same denomination and that the Storrs Congregational Church, representing the Congregational denomination, received a larger vote than either of the other churches.

It is, therefore, ordered by the Court that the said A.L. Tischbein, Trustee under the will of the said Ethan Stone, deceased, pay the entire amount received by him under the will of said decedent for the support of religion in Storrs Township for ten years beginning May 1, 1924, to the Storrs Congregational Church.

The undersigned, A. L. Tischbein, trustee under the will of Ethan Stone, deceased, respectfully reports that in accordance with the order of the Common Pleas Court in the case of A. L. Tischbein, trustee, against St. Martini German Protestant Evangelical Church, et al, No. 95351 dated December 27, 1923, min. 1718, he gave notice of the decennial election held October 1, 1923 provided for in said will, by duly advertising the same, of which proofs of publication are filed herein, for three weeks preceding said election in the Cincinnati Times-Star in free press papers of general circulation of Hamilton County; that said election was duly held under said notice at the time and places therein specified and from the poll books and reports returned to him by the judges and clerks of the election at the polls, there were 2686 votes cast, of which 1141 votes were cast for St. Martini German Protestant Evangelical Church, 238 votes were cast for the First German Protestant Church of Price Hill, and 1307 votes were cast for the Storrs Congregational Church. Said Trustee is unable to determine to which of the Churches above named the fund given by the Will of Ethan Stone, Deceased, for the support of religion in Storrs Township shall be paid by the said trustee for the ten years succeeding said election and beginning January 1, A.D., 1924, and, therefore, asks that the Court determine the same.
