This day this cause came on to be heard upon the report heretofore filed herein by The Cincinnati Bank and Trust Company, as Trustee under the will of Ethan Stone, deceased, of an election held on Monday, April 10, 1944 to determine the recipient of a church fund for ten (10) years next ensuing from May 1st, 1944 to be used in the propagation of the Protestant religion in the former Township of Storrs, Hamilton County, Ohio, as provided in the will of said decedent, and upon the evidence, and was submitted to the court: On consideration whereof, and being fully advised in the premises, the court finds that due notice of the holding of said church fund election, on said April 10, 1944, between the hours of 12 M. and 8:00 P. M. at the three voting places mentioned in said notice, was caused to be given by said trustee aforesaid by advertisement in The Cincinnati Times Star, a newspaper of general circulation in Hamilton County, Ohio, once a week for three consecutive weeks prior to the day of said election; that uniform ballots prepared under the direction and supervision of this court, together with the necessary accessories for the marking of said ballots, were furnished and by said trustee aforesaid caused to be delivered at the three voting places specified in said notice prior to the opening of the polls, and that proper and suitable persons were selected and appointed as judges and clerks of said election, was duly held on the day, at the places and between the hours mentioned in said notices, and that the result of said election as expressed in the poll-books and certified to by the judges and clerks at said election is as follows:

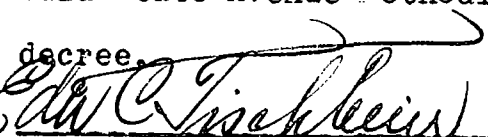

The Court further finds that The Evangelical Denomination represented by The Martini Evangelical Protestant Church received a total of 309 votes; that The Evangelical Denomination represented by The Price Hill Evangelical Church received a total of 218 votes; that the Methodist Denomination represented by State Avenue Methodist Church received a total of 511 votes.

The Court further finds that the Methodist Denomination represented by State Avenue Methodist Church, having received the largest number of votes cast at said election, according to the decree entered in the Court of Common Pleas, Hamilton County, Ohio, designating denomination, is the successful contestant at said election aforesaid and as such is entitled to receive the net church fund provided for in the will of said Ethan Stone, deceased, for the ten (10) years next ensuing from May 1, 1944.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged, and decreed that said State Avenue Methodist Church, be, and is hereby declared and designated as the recipient of the net church fund for the propagation of the Protestant religion in said former Township of Storrs, Hamilton County, Ohio for the ten (10) year period next ensuing from May 1, 1944 and further that the trustee herein be, and he is hereby ordered to pay said net church fund arising under the will of said decedent to said State Avenue Methodist Church in accordance with the terms of this order and decree.

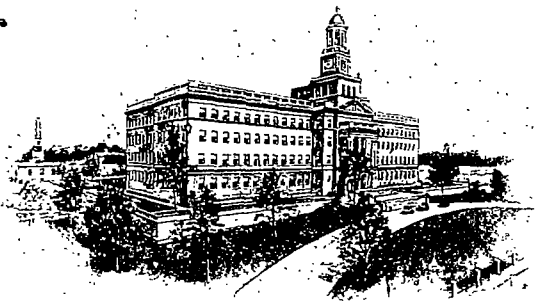

The Will of Ethan Stone was executed on June 17, 1850. He died two or three years afterwards. The Will creates perpetual trusts for religious use.

It is easy to understand that in the 95 years that have elapsed since Ethan Stone's death there have been great economic, social, religious and philosophical changes. In recognition of that fact perpetual trusts similar to those created by Ethan Stone are no longer permissible.

There is little question of the intent of the decedent, which was to use remainders of his estate in order to give income in perpetuity for the growth of the Episcopal Church. However, the testator could not foresee the changing needs of the Episcopal Church.

On the 4th page of the decedent's Will appears this wording:

"And the other fourth part I direct my executors so to invest that it shall produce an annual income, and that three fourths of said income be paid annually to Augusta Stone the wife of my said nephew Dan Stone during her natural life, and after her decease to the said Dan Stone during his natural life & after the decease of both of them, the said three fourths of said income shall go to the Trustees of Cincinnati College in trust to be by them applied to the education of indigent scholars, preparing for the ministry in the Episcopal Church; and the remaining one fourth of said income shall go to my nephew Henry Pease during his natural life, and after his decease, the whole of said income shall go to the said Trustees of Cincinnati College in trust to be applied by them to the education of indigent scholars preparing for the ministry in the Episcopal Church."

October 30, 1945

The Cincinnati College having ceased to exist, Judges of the Probate Court of Hamilton County designated successor trustees. Those serving at present are: The Rt. Rev. Henry Wise Hobson, Bishop of the Diocese of Southern Ohio; The Rev. J. Hollister Lynch, Episcopal Clergyman, and Edwin F. Pierle. These trustees receive income from property originating from the estate of Ethan Stone, deceased, said property being administered by the Central Trust Company as trustee. In addition, the said trustees have accumulated several thousands of dollars, almost all of which is invested in United States Government Bonds, chiefly of the War Bond series, said balance representing unexpended income of previous years.

The trustees above mentioned and their predecessors have made diligent effort to find worthy "indigent scholars preparing for the ministry in the Episcopal Church," at times with sufficient success so as to reduce materially the accumulated balance of unexpended income. However, endowments of seminaries reduce the students needs, facilities for candidates for the ministry which enable them to earn substantial portions of their financial requirements while performing work that in itself is training for the ministry, and probably the improved financial circumstances of students themselves, at times make it difficult to find worthy recipients for grants from the Ministerial Fund. For several years to come it is probable that many scholars preparing for the ministry will have accumulated savings resulting from military service or will be entitled to educational grants by reason of the so-called "GI Bill of Rights."

The trustees are mindful of the responsibilities of their trust. They seek, and will continue to seek, worthy recipients of grants given in full appreciation of the letter and spirit of the Will of the late Ethan Stone.

However, in furtherance of their trust, and in an effort to find worthy, indigent scholars preparing for the ministry of the Episcopal Church, the said trustees respectfully present the following questions, requesting your guidance and interpretation of the admonition given by the Will:

In 1850, when the Will was executed, it is extremely doubtful if Ethan Stone considered the possibility that women would come to play an important part in religious education in the Episcopal Church. In the 95 years that have elapsed, steady progress towards the emancipation of women has been recorded, until today, politically and economically, they have achieved equal status with men.

Although the Episcopal Church has not as yet permitted the ordination of women, their use as vital agents in religious education for the

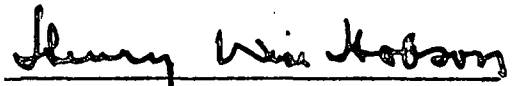

Episcopal Church presents not only an opportunity for them, but particularly permits the church to fill a long felt and important need. There is need for the training of more consecrated, capable women in work that is part of the ministry of the Episcopal Church, although not as yet dignified by the title and authorities of the comprehensive term "ministry."

The trustees, therefore, would like instructions as to whether or not their interpretation of the testator's direction to apply income "to the education of indigent scholars preparing for the ministry in the Episcopal Church" will permit them to make grants from the Ministerial Funds to the education of indigent female scholars preparing for religious education and/or social service work incidental to the ministry in the Episcopal Church.

We, the undersigned, trustees believe the use of funds as above indicated will be consonant with the obvious wishes of the testator, Ethan Stone. It is our belief that had he lived under the influence of today's broader vision of the capabilities of women for work in essential phases of the ministry of the Episcopal Church, he would have used a broader term than the word "ministry" which, technically, usually means "ordained ministers."
