ENTRY TERMINATING TESTAMENTARY TRUST

This matter came for hearing on Account and on the Motion of the Bishop's Fund of Southern Ohio to terminate a Testamentary Trust of Ethan Stone arising from Paragraph 16 of Mr Stone's will For good cause shown, it is ordered as follows

1 The 35<sup>th</sup> Current Account covering the period from June 21, 2010 to June 30, 2012 is approved as filed

2 The value of the Trust as of June 30, 2012 was as reported in the 35<sup>th</sup> Current Account The balance reported by PNC Bank, N A , Trustee as of October 30, 2012 is \$74, 279 00

3 No further expenses or fees are being sought or will be ordered, beyond those approved as stated in the 35<sup>th</sup> Current Account

4 The testamentary trust of Ethan Stone provided in paragraph 16 of his will is hereby ordered terminated for the following reasons In accordance with Ohio Rev Code §2109 62(A)(1), the Court finds that (a) it is no longer economically feasible to continue the trust, (b) the termination of the trust is for the benefit of the beneficiaries, (c) the termination of the trust is equitable and practical, and (d) the current value of the trust is less than one hundred thousand dollars Termination of the trust and disbursement of the remaining balance to The Discretionary Fund of the Bishop of Southern Ohio will ensure that the remaining funds will be more directly used for the purposes provided by Mr Stone in paragraph 16 of his will

5 PNC Bank, N A , Trustee, is hereby ordered to distribute the remaining funds held by it in the account known as the "Ethan Stone Trust" to The Discretionary Fund of the Bishop of Southern Ohio, Diocese of Southern Ohio of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the United States of America, otherwise known as the Episcopal Church, to be used for the education of persons studying to become Episcopal clergy, as Mr Stone intended After making this distribution, PNC Bank, N A , Trustee is thereby discharged as Trustee, with no further account to be prepared for submittal to this Court
