

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF

GRACE WOLFSON

I, GRACE WOLFSON, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, now residing and legally domiciled in Phelps County, Missouri, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument to be my last will, revoking all wills and codicils by me at any time heretofore made.

FIRST: I direct the prompt payment of all my lawful debts and the expenses of my last illness and funeral. Except with respect to property over which I have a power of appointment which does not become part of my probate estate, and except for taxes imposed on my estate for which my personal representative has a right of recovery under Sections 2207A or 2207B of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any successor provisions, all federal estate taxes and state estate and inheritance taxes imposed as a result of my death, together with any interest or penalties thereon, shall be paid from the residue of my estate, without any apportionment or right of recoupment and regardless of whether the property giving rise to those taxes passes under or outside of this Will.

If any property which is eligible for election for treatment as qualified terminable interest property is not so elected, then any increase in the federal estate taxes payable by my estate as a result of such non-election shall be paid directly from such non-elected property, and my personal representative is directed to seek reimbursement from such non-elected property or to withhold taxes from property passing from my estate.

SECOND: I am married to John Wolfson, and I have a son from a previous marriage, Henry Edward Metzner. My husband has one stepson from a previous marriage, Peter Hans Neumann. I intentionally make no provision for any person who is not named hereinafter.

THIRD: I give, devise and bequeath all of the remaining property of all kinds wherever situated belonging to me at the time of my death to the then acting Trustee under the Grace Wolfson Trust executed by me this date before the execution of this Will, as amended, to be held, administered and distributed pursuant to the provisions of that Trust Agreement.

In the event for any reason the bequest and devise above is ineffective and invalid, then I hereby give, devise and bequeath the rest, residue and remainder of my property of every kind and description (including lapsed legacies and devises), wherever situate and whether acquired before or after the execution of this Will, to the successor Trustee to be held, administered and distributed in accordance with the provisions of that certain Trust Agreement between myself Settlor and myself as Trustee executed on this date prior to the execution of this Will, which Trust Agreement is hereby incorporated by reference and made a part hereof the same as if the entire Trust Agreement were set forth herein. If for any reason the successor Trustee named therein is unable or unwilling to serve, then I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint as successor or substitute Trustee a bank or trust company qualified to do business in the State of my domicile at the time of my death, which successor or substitute Trustee shall be designated in a written instrument filed with the court having jurisdiction over this Will and signed by my son or if he fails to act by his wife or if she fails to act by my oldest living grandchild or if she fails to act by the court having jurisdiction over the probate of my estate.

FOURTH: Any portion of my estate which is to be distributed by my Personal Representative to the Trustee of any trust estate created under the Trust described above under paragraph THIRD, which portion would be immediately distributable free from trust by such Trustee, shall be distributed by



my Personal Representative directly to the person or persons who would be entitled to receive the same from such Trustee.

FIFTH: I nominate and appoint my son, Henry E. Metzner, Personal Representative of this, my last will and testament. If he does not survive me or is unable or unwilling to serve, then I nominate and appoint my son's wife, Anita F. Metzner, Personal Representative. If she does not survive me or is unable or unwilling to serve, then I nominate and appoint my granddaughter, Suzanne G. Metzner, Personal Representative. I request that none of them be required to post bond.

My Personal Representatives named herein are authorized to administer my estate under independent administration without adjudication, order or direction of the court.

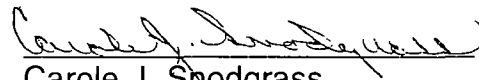
